

Restoration Project Management

Participant Registration for 2017

The Restoration Project Management course is designed to give project managers in the restoration industry the tools and skills needed to manage projects efficiently and effectively. This intense program requires active participation and total commitment from every student enrolled. Class size is limited to ensure individual attention to each student.

Prerequisites

Education

- All Applicants must hold a high school diploma or equivalent.

Work History & Experience

- Applicants must have a minimum of three (3) years of verifiable work experience in the restoration field or similar industry.
- Qualified candidates will have worked in at least one of the following roles: project manager, project coordinator, technician, project supervisor, estimator, company manager, facility manager or owner.

Program Costs

Early bird discount of \$255 when registered by December 31, 2016!

Program cost: \$4,250 per student (\$3,995 if registered by 12/31/16), payable in US dollars.

Fee includes: Tuition, class materials*, breakfast, snack, coffee breaks, and lunch on class days.

Deposit: A deposit of \$500 is due with registration. The deposit will be refunded in the event that the applicant does not qualify or is not accepted into the program.

Balance: The remaining balance is due on or before February 24, 2017.

** All study materials needed for the program are included in the program fees. Any optional or supplemental materials that may be required are at your own cost.*

Cancellation, Withdrawal, and Refund Policy

Once you are accepted into the Restoration Project Management program, you have reserved a seat in the class for the entire program. The program requires and depends on substantial student participation and is structured to operate with all seats occupied. If you withdraw from the program or fail to attend remaining classes anytime during the program, your seat will remain open and cannot be resold.

All payments received by Violand Management Associates for your enrollment in the program are subject to the following refund policy:

- Cancellations received **prior to February 24, 2017** will receive a full refund of the fees paid.
- Cancellations received **after February 24, 2017** will receive a refund of the fees paid, less the \$500 deposit which will be held in escrow and applied to any future VMA program.

There will be no refunds for classes that have already taken place or for classes missed. Cancellation fees for withdrawal from the program once it has started will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. A written request for withdrawal will be required.
